A long while ago, I had a friend who was Sr. Lynn Tooma, SSND. She was older than I and wiser...she was all of forty! But Lynn was wise beyond her years, and her friendship and counsel meant the world to me. She had a way of putting life into perspective...a faith perspective.

One day, we were talking about a friend of mine. She asked how he was doing. I told her that I hadn't heard from him...that I had called him the last two times, and it was his turn to call me.

Sr. Lynn looked at me and said, "Ruth, love doesn't keep score." She went on to say that my friend was having a difficult time in his life, and if it meant reaching out to him 500 times, I should do it. And I should do it because "love doesn't keep score."

One day, Sr. Lynn jokingly reminded me of that when she called me and said, "I know it is not my turn to call you, but we haven't gotten together for a while, and I really need one of our long chats. I am leaving in a few minutes for a conference. As soon as I come back, we are going to meet."

Sr. Lynn died at that conference. She was only forty years old. I am grateful for all that Sr. Lynn taught me; but mostly for teaching me that love doesn't keep score. That is the message of today's Gospel. "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

Many of us have friends and family that for one reason or another have walked out on our lives. Sometimes, it is for a silly reason, or a reason not even known to us. Sometimes, the person needed to leave for the same reason the prodigal son left...to seek his own pleasure, fame, and fortune. The challenge for disciples is to love the other even in their absence, to reach out to them, to stop keeping score. And even if the person never returns, never enters our life again, never acknowledges a card we sent or the birth of a child...still we learn how to love that person more and more each day.

Love...Christ's love...doesn't keep score.
